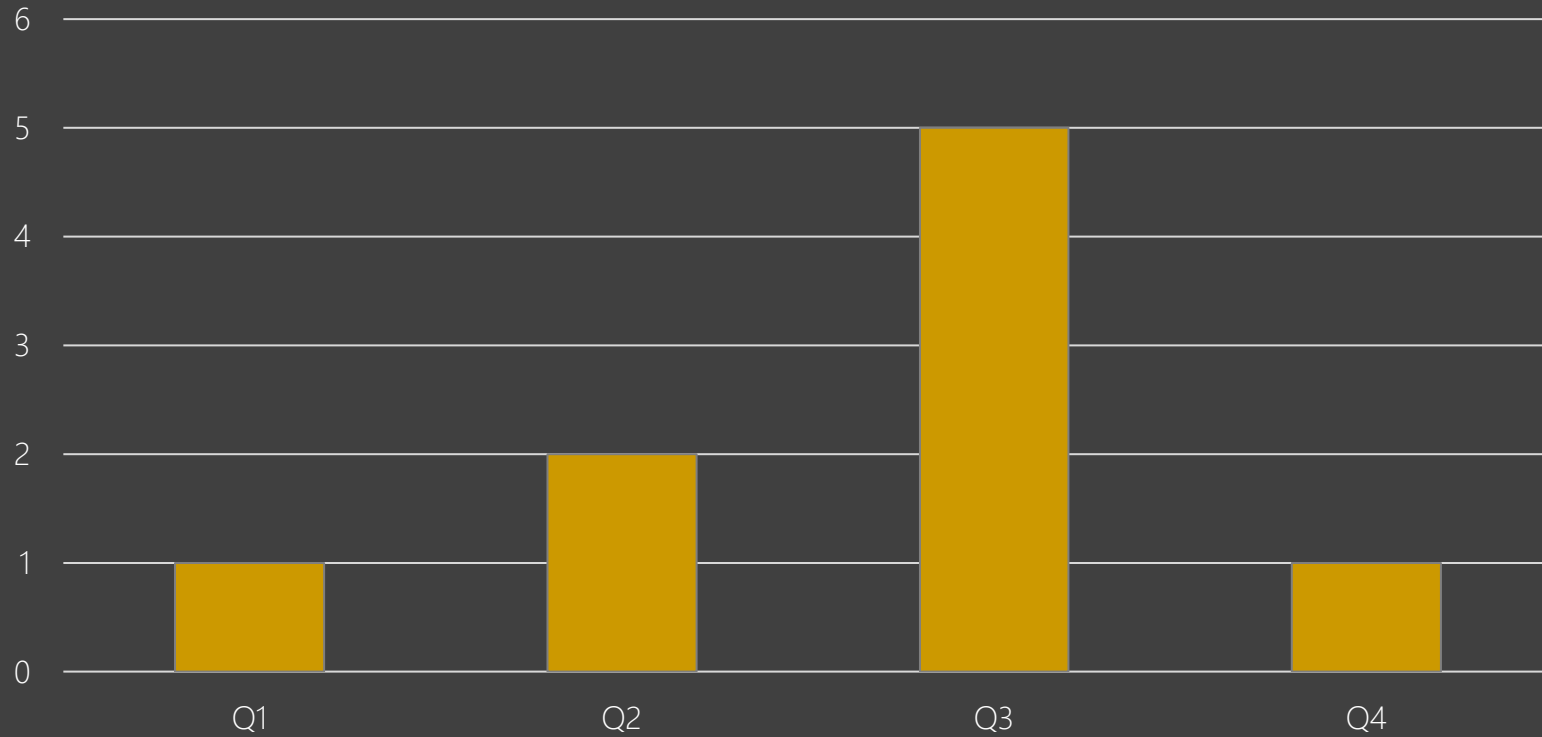

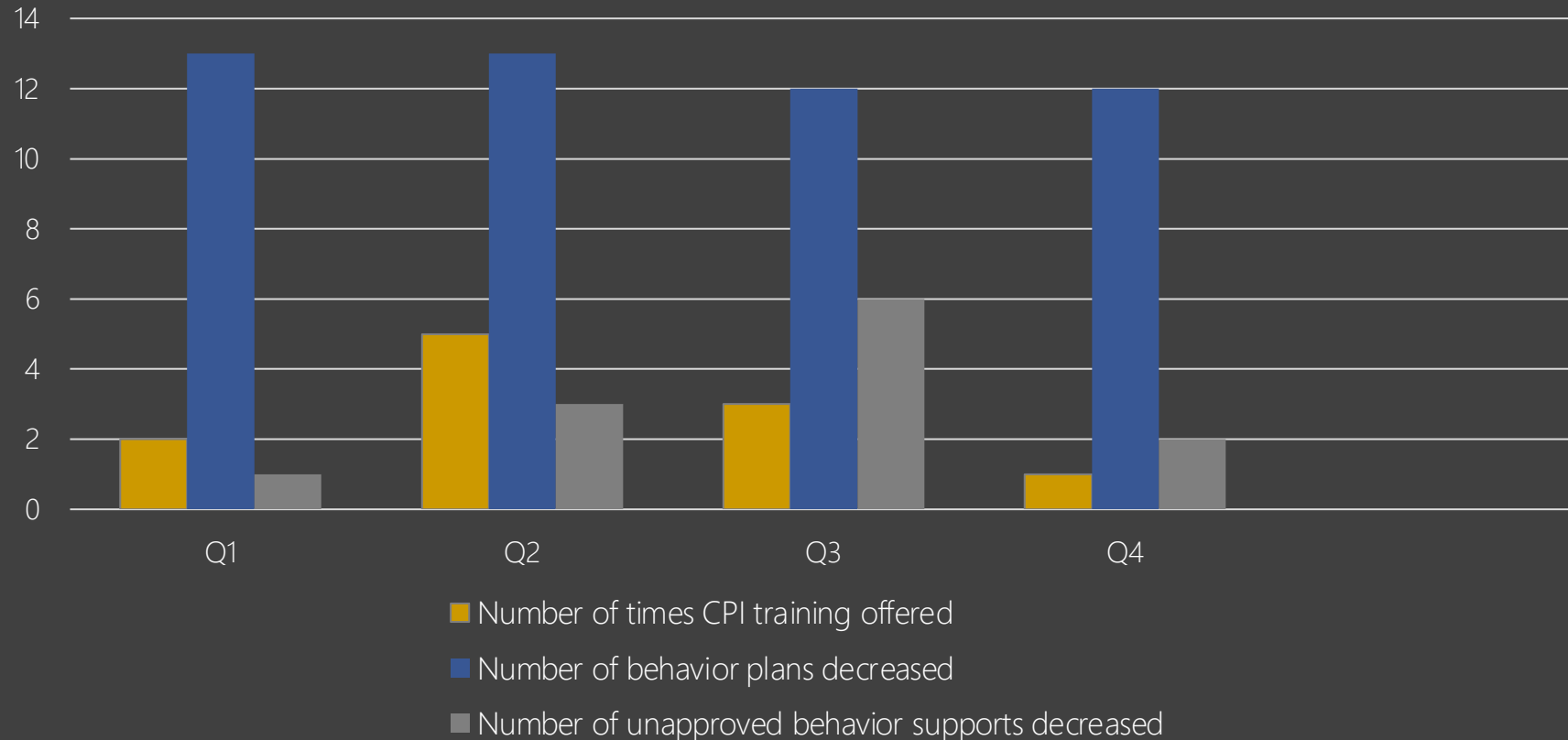

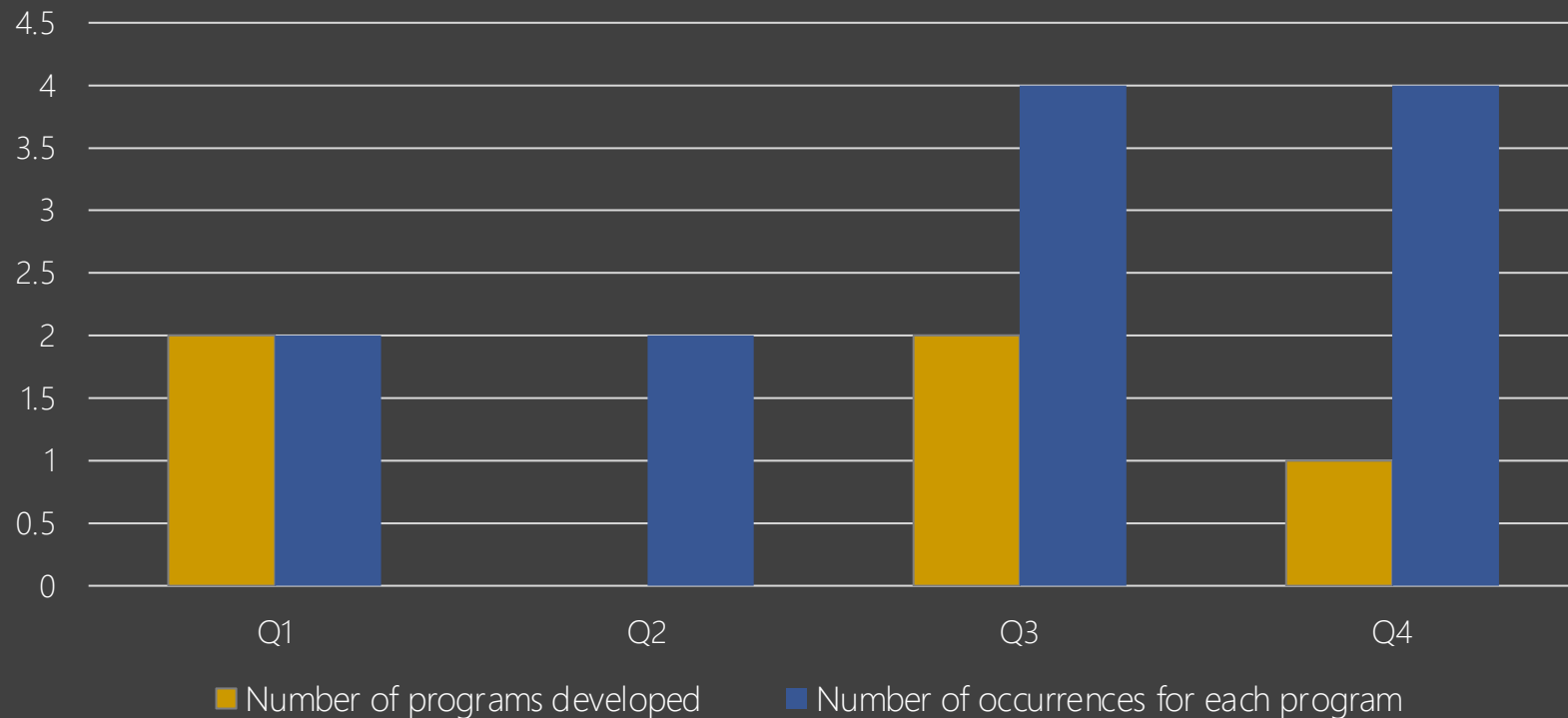

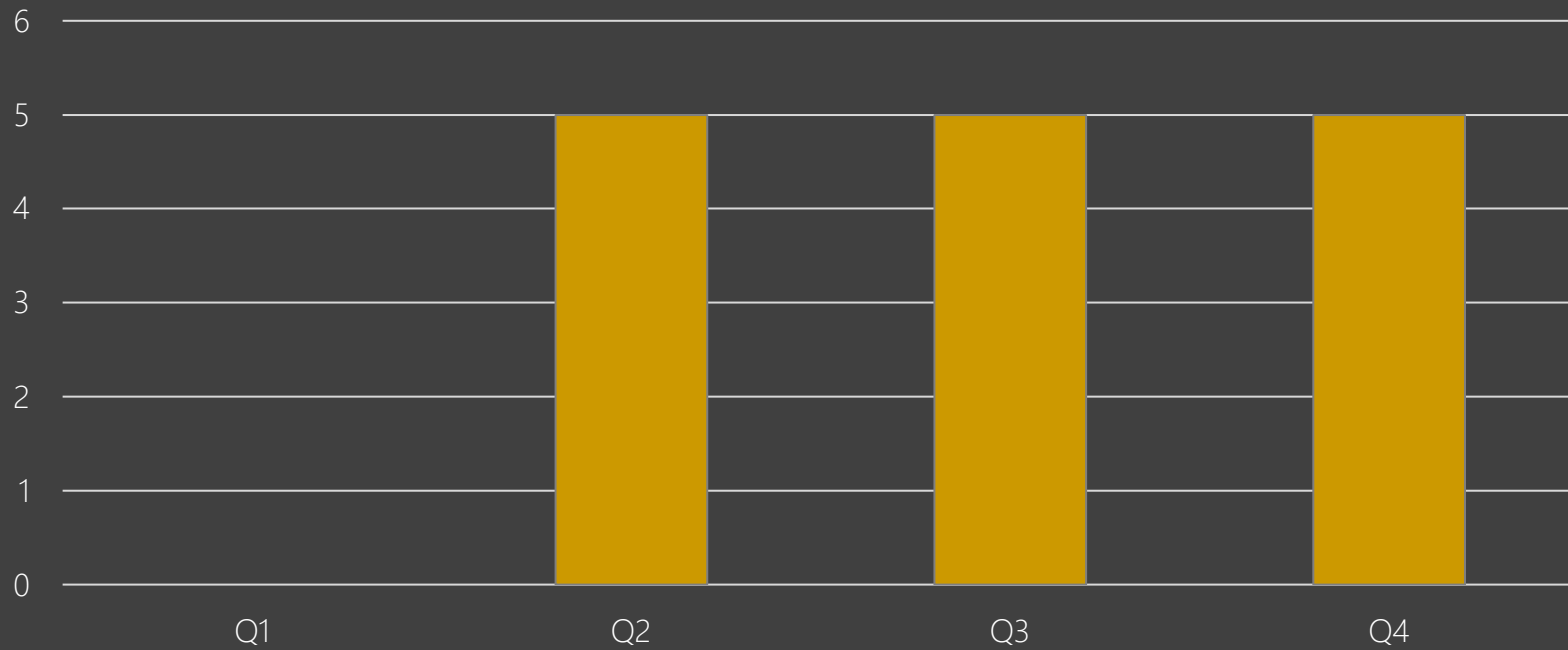

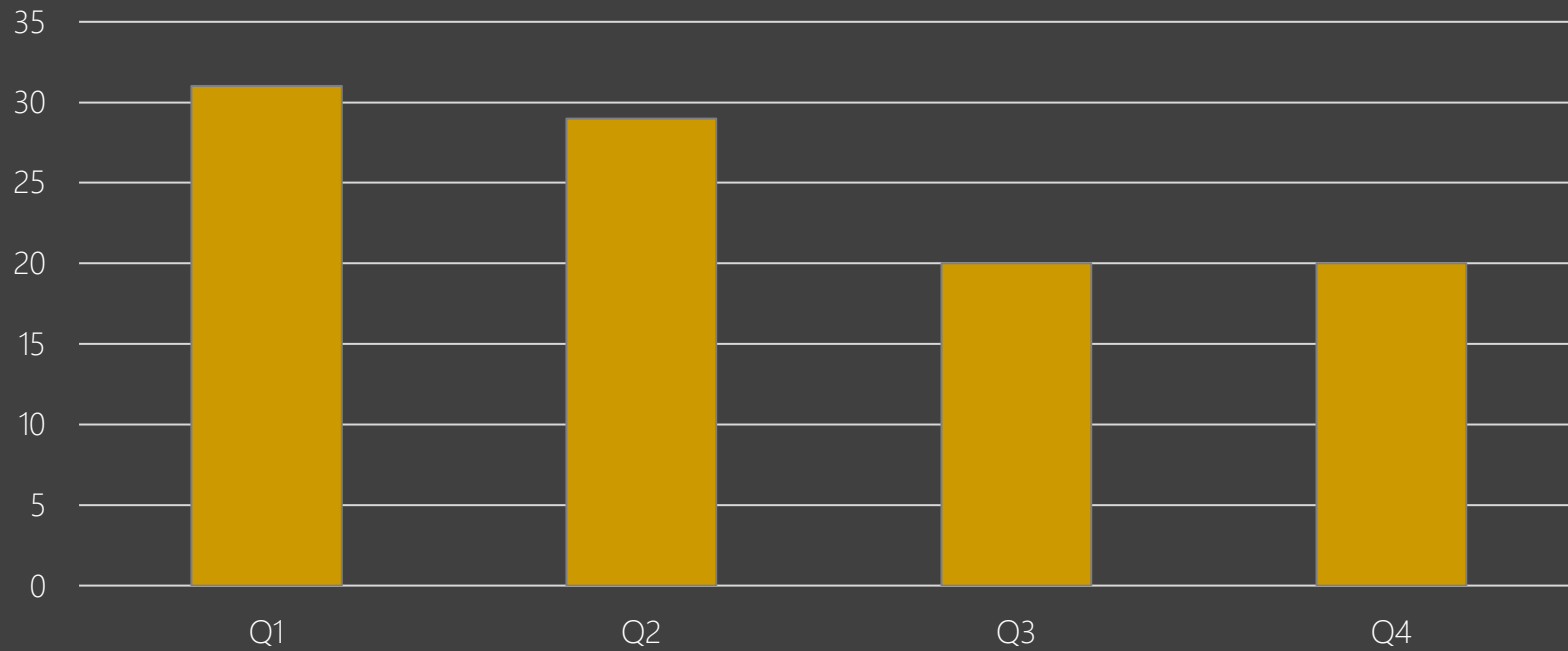

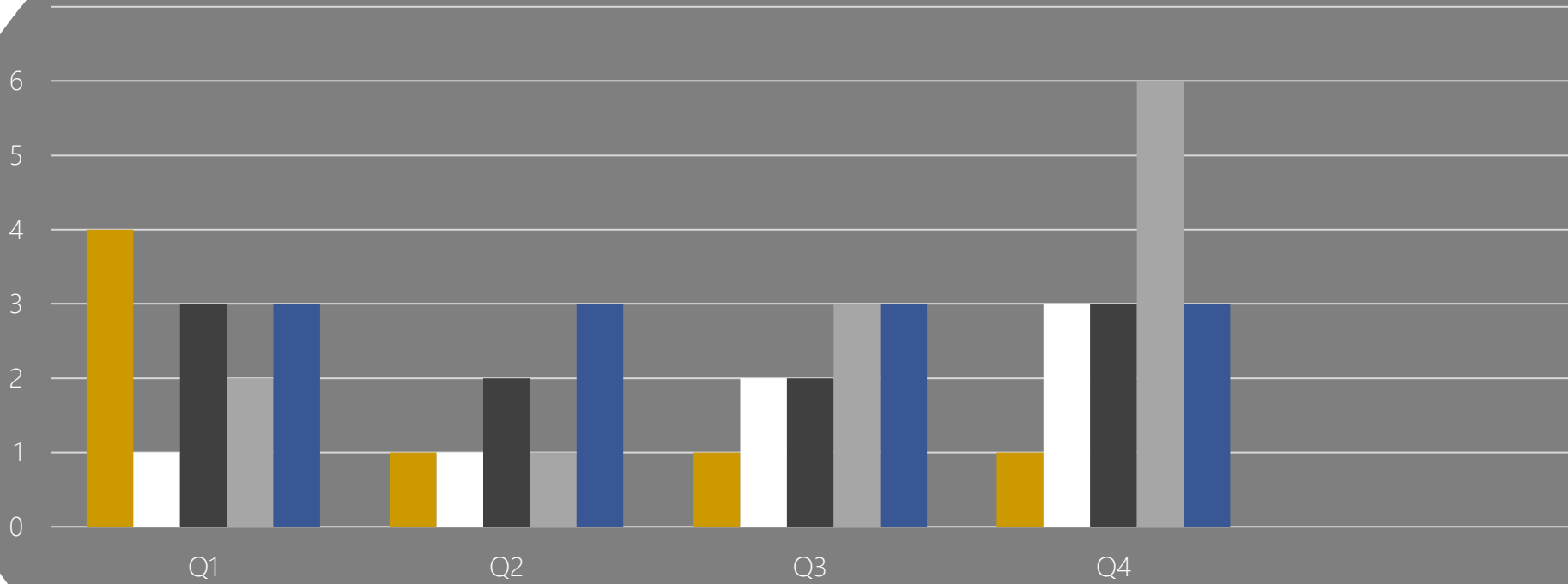

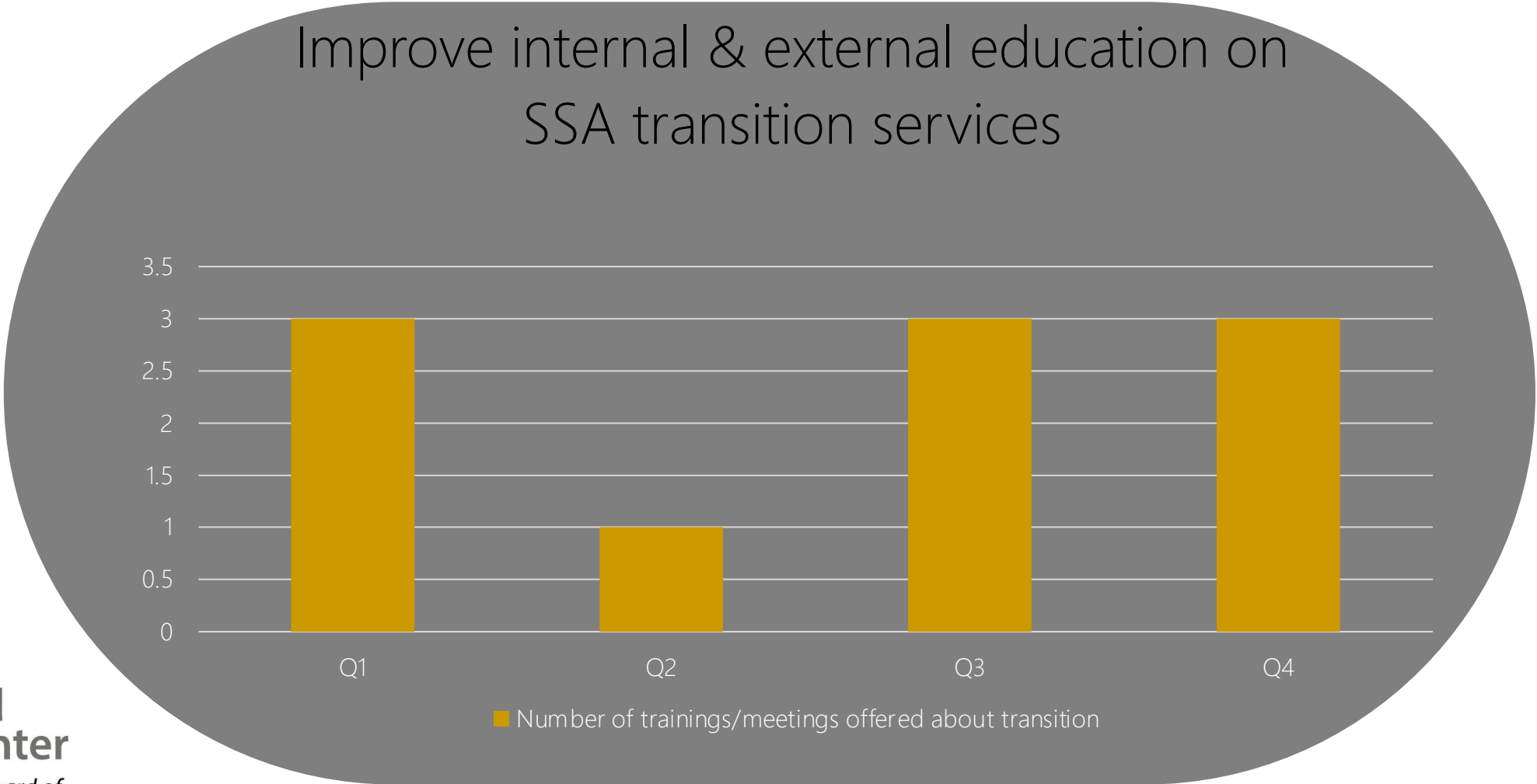

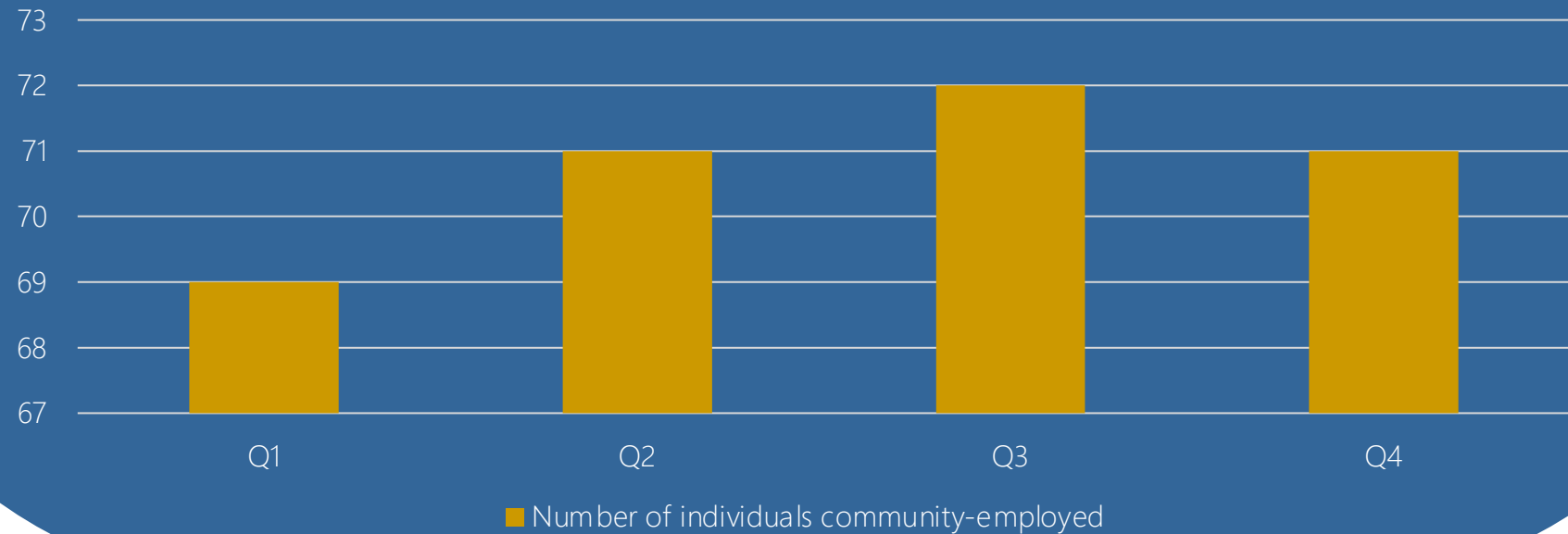
'Road Show' of advocacy opportunities off-site
