



Ohio Department of Medicaid

Services listed below can be applied for by visiting the local Ohio Department of Job & Family Services (ODJFS). The local ODJFS office for Hancock County is located at 7814 Co. Rd. 140 Findlay, OH.

Eligibility for Medicaid Services are:

- Ohio resident
- US citizen or meet Medicaid citizenship requirements
- Have or obtain a social security number
- Meeting certain financial eligibility requirements

Programs offered for individuals with disabilities are Medicaid for Older Adults & People with Disabilities (ABD) and Medicaid Buy In for Workers with Disabilities. (MBIWD)

Medicaid for Older Adults & People with Disabilities Programs: are for older adults and people with disabilities to assist with medical expenses. Programs provides health care coverage consisting of primary & acute care services as well as long-term care. To be eligible for these services, along with meeting the basic Medicaid requirements, a person must be age 65 or older, or legally blind, or have a disability as defined by Social Security Administration.

Medicaid Buy In for Workers with Disabilities (MBIWD): This program can provide health care coverage to working Ohioans with a disabilities between the ages of 16 & 64 whose income may exceed the limit for Medicaid eligibility.
