



***Who conducts the Waiting List Assessment?***

Your SSA will complete the Waiting List Assessment with you.

***Why is a Waiting List assessment conducted?***

The Waiting List Assessment will help identify if you have no needs, a current need or an immediate need.

***How do I know if I will be placed on the Waiting List?***

If you do not have any identified needs you will not be placed on the Waiting List.

If you have a current need and the county board is unable to enroll you on an available waiver you will be placed on the Waiting List.

If you have an immediate need you will not be placed on the Waiting List. The county board will identify and offer you resources available to meet your needs within 30 days.

***What can I do if I don't agree with the outcome of the Waiting List Assessment?***

If you do not agree with the outcome of the assessment you can file an appeal. The county board will provide you with information on how to make an appeal.

***What can I do if my needs change?***

If your needs change you can ask the county board to go through the assessment process again.
